

INTERIOR DESIGN CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Interior Design Certificate Program is an overview of the elements in interior design through lectures and problem solving projects. You will learn how to create with knowledge and confidence, residential and commercial interiors that are both functional and beautiful.

The emphasis in this program is the application of interior design projects to include:

- ◆ Color
- ◆ Design elements and design principles
- ◆ History
- ◆ Textiles (fabric and interior materials)
- ◆ Drawing, codes and standards
- ◆ Business practices

The skills learned in this 12-module (249 hour) program will equip the student in all aspects of residential and commercial design. In addition to the required core courses, electives addressing issues vital to the interior designer will also be offered.

Upon successful completion of all required core courses listed, the participant will receive a certificate of satisfactory completion and earn continuing education units (CEU's) of 24.9 hrs. Satisfactory completion means attending at least 80 percent of each of the individual course classes and completing all projects as assigned by the instructor.
